Pearls in management of Allergic Fungal Rhinosinusitis

Abstract

Rhinoplasty AFRS is a disease with a varied presentation. It takes an alert clinician to identify the disease and subsequently manage the condition. Although surgical debridement remains the mainstay of treatment protocol it doesnot always lead to a long term disease free state.
